Tutorials in Urodynamics

Tutorials in urodynamics are intensive, small group courses in practical urodynamics. They are designed for nurse/technicians, clinicians and others with limited urodynamics experience, who need to acquire basic proficiency and understanding that they can put into practice immediately.

Each course provides a mix of tutorial sessions, hands-on practice and patient examinations, and is designed to develop good urodynamic technique in a quick and efficient manner. The sessions, practicums and examinations are personally tutored by Dr. Derek Griffiths, who is one of the world's most experienced and most respected urodynamicists.

The number of participants in each course is limited to only four, guaranteeing individualized instruction and direct, hands-on experience in the principles and practice of urodynamics. Laborie and/or Dentec equipment is available. The course is tailored to fit the individual needs of the participants. The course schedule includes several actual urodynamics examinations, which all participants attend and discuss with Dr. Griffiths and the urodynamics staff.

The course is held at the urodynamics unit in Edmonton, Alberta, starting on Thursday evening and ending on Saturday evening. Participants receive a certificate of attendance.

The cost of the 2-3 day course, including the course workbook, all lunches and coffee breaks and 2 evening meals, is \$600.00 US. Hotel accommodation can be arranged in the Fantasyland Hotel, West Edmonton Mall, a short walk from the urodynamics unit. There is an opportunity to explore this renowned mall on Saturday evening. Edmonton International Airport is served by direct flights from Minneapolis-St. Paul, Salt Lake City, Seattle, and all major airports in Canada. Air fares are relatively low because of the Saturday night stopover.

The next courses of 1997 will be held in April, May and later months.
